Each proposed theme will be addressed by specific workgroups in order to:

- share information, know-how and practices within a broader community
- identify common criteria and standards
- disseminate good practices and lessons learned with special reference to new policy approaches

Working tools

- ✦ *exchange events* to share information and to enable MS to acquire a common understanding of practices
- ✦ *peer review* to acquire a broader understanding of validated good practices and to support systematic experience transfer processes, tools and measures to enhance employment and social cohesion

Management bodies and roles

- Steering Group (Esf MAs, E.C., workgroup co-ordinators): planning and monitoring the activities of the network and its outcomes
- The Italian Ministry of Labour: managing and coordinating activities
- The European Commission: promoting the European dimension of the Network
- Isfol: providing technical and scientific support for the general management of the Network
